Our initiatives include

- Release of classroom teachers and teacher aids to collaboratively work together to review Whole School Pedagogical Framework.
- Through Regional support, school will focus on differentiation for all learners to ensure the provision of individualised and appropriate curriculum levels.

- Funds spent on engaging TRS – relief teaching staff and /or Contract teaching staff to allow school staff release time so as to participate in Professional Development as intentional collaboration.
