IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Medication

There may be time where your child requires medication at school. Safety of your children is paramount to the staff at MCSS, so with this in mind it is important to remember the following:

Before any medication can be administered to your child at school, you will need to complete the appropriate record sheet, which will be available to you upon request;

Medication will only be administered if it is prescribed, in the original container and has a pharmacy label. If the medication is more complex with specific administration requirements then a letter from the medical practitioner should be provided;

Under no circumstances should your child be encouraged to self-medicate (including asthma medications) unless you have discussed this with either your child's teacher or principal. This system has been developed by the Department of Education to ensure the safety of your child and their classmates. Thank you for your cooperation.

Communication with staff

The staff at MCSS encourage parent participation in your child's learning. If at any stage throughout the year you have any concerns or questions about your child's progress, please do not hesitate to speak to the appropriate staff member to have your questions addressed.

Where possible, it is always best to make an appointment with staff to have a respectful conversation. Respectful relationships between staff, students and families are always promoted at MCSS.

Drop off, pick up, and bus travel

The bus shelter is an exceptionally busy place at the end of our school day. We understand that many students have extra-curricular activities and that the travel from Mena Creek into town can complicate things and that sometimes, pick up from school may look a little different. To ensure your child is safe please, in the afternoon notify the teacher on bus duty before your child leaves the school grounds.

If a change to your child's transportation is required, please call both the school (**4065 3221**) AND Trans North if it involves bus travel (**3036 2070**) to ensure that your child's transportation needs are met safely.
